# THIRD QUARTER 2025 REPORT MISSIONS SUPPORT

Your gifts supported these local and international missions:

- ACT (Abuse Counseling & Treatment), received a \$1,000 donation.
- Blankets & Blessings serving local homeless received \$2,500.
- Our Sister Church in Cuba received \$1,000.
- Residing Hope, Children's home, received \$3,000!
- Rice & Beans: We packed 6,000 lbs of rice and beans in August for the Food Pantry at a cost of \$3.870.





- New Life Missionaries: the Groves received \$1,000 for their ministry!

### THIRD QUARTER 2025 REPORT CHURCH FINANCE

- Financially Speaking, the 3rd Qtr is seasonally lower in attendance and contributions. This year, total 3rd qtr. giving to our budget was 16% lower than anticipated. Attendance has improved 13% from last year and that is good news!
- So, we are watching our expenses very closely and asking for your assistance.
- This year, we have remained on track paying 100% of our apportionments.
- Unfortunately we had a series of unbudgeted air conditioner problems.
   During the 3rd quarter, we spent \$28,000 for AC replacement and repairs. Gifts of \$5,020 were received to offset some of these AC expenditures.



 Another large unbudgeted expense was having our street sign repaired and refurbished costing \$8,100.
