

Frequently Asked Questions

What is this about?

The "Here We Are, Lord" campaign is Faith United Methodist Church's 2024 program to communicate our ministry plans for the year and seek your financial support through giving and pledges. Held at the beginning of each year when most members and guests are present, our annual campaign leads the way for us all to express gratitude for the blessings received from God. Our stewardship, a manifestation of love and thankfulness, involves sharing and reciprocating God's love. We invite you to contribute to Faith's mission of Loving, Worshiping, and Serving, allowing us to Love God and Love People. To achieve our ministry plans, if you are able, we are requesting an 8% increase in giving for 2024.

▶ Why is it important to return the Commitment Card and pledge?

Annual pledges and gifts sustain all aspects of Faith UMC, covering staff salaries, supporting outreach ministries, and maintaining our beautiful worship spaces. Your financial commitments are crucial for the effective execution of our ministry plans. The attached pie chart shows where your gifts are put to work.

➤ What if I'm not a member of Faith UMC?

If you're not full time here, and a member of another Church, please honor your commitment there but consider supporting Faith UMC, as your Florida Church home, with a gift as well. All attendees at Faith UMC are invited to share their blessings by completing the Commitment Card to support our ministries. We also encourage you to consider elevating your commitment by becoming a Member or Associate Member.

What do I do if I already gave my gift at the beginning of the year?

Please join us in our Commitment and Celebration Sundays by submitting a Commitment Card. Please also consider making a supplemental gift during the year to support our targeted increase in giving.

> What do I need to do if I give either electronically or automatically from my financial institution?

Contact your financial institution to change or confirm the amount you wish to send to Faith UMC and at what frequency. If you give via our web site, please log on to make any changes to your gift. Contact the office for web help.

What if I want to give stocks or other assets?

We can accept stocks and some other financial instruments as gifts. Please contact the office for specifics.

What if my financial situation changes during the year?

We know that life happens. If circumstances change you can notify the church to change your pledge. If you're blessed with unexpected income, you're always welcome to increase your pledge too!

How does this fit with the Faith and Future campaign to retire the mortgage?

The <u>Faith and Future</u> campaign is an on-going three-year initiative aimed at retiring our Sanctuary mortgage, and we are on track thanks to your contributions. We encourage you to maintain your giving plan for that program. However, we kindly request that those gifts are separate and not reduce your annual giving and pledge to the 2024 <u>Here We Are, Lord</u> campaign.

➤ What do I do with the Commitment Card once I have filled it in?

The card can be returned to Faith UMC during Worship Service on Commitment Sunday on February 11, dropped in any collection basket on any other Sunday, dropped off at the office during office hours, or mailed to Faith UMC at 15690 McGregor Blvd, Fort Myers, FL 33908.

WANT TO GIVE MORE WITHOUT COSTING YOU MORE?

Dear Faith Church Family,

As your Treasurer, it is my desire to ensure that our valued members and guests are informed about opportunities to support Faith Church while also securing tax advantages for themselves during retirement. One often-overlooked strategy is the Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD).

A QCD allows individuals aged 70½ or older with most IRAs to contribute directly from their accounts to a qualified charity, such as Faith Church, excluding that withdrawal from their taxable income.

Notably, for those facing Required Minimum Distributions (RMDs) from their IRAs at age 72, utilizing QCDs satisfies the RMD requirement while providing tax savings simultaneously.

So, as an example, if you are in a 12% tax bracket, you can give your designated charities up to 12% more without costing you anything. Higher tax brackets increase the opportunity proportionally.

By extracting money from the IRA without adding it to your income, you can avoid ordinary income taxes on that withdrawal. Moreover, since it fulfills your RMD, you avoid taxes on income that would otherwise be reportable. This creates a win-win scenario! Additionally, if you pay income-related monthly adjustment amounts (IRMAA) to Medicare, reducing your income through QCDs will also decrease those payments – a triple win!

Initiating a QCD is straightforward – simply inform your IRA custodian of the donation amount and its intended recipient (e.g., Faith Church) to arrange for the direct transfer. It is recommended to consult your own tax or financial advisor to assess how a QCD or any other strategy aligns with your unique financial situation.

If you need help in understanding or setting up such a donation, while we are not tax experts, we can provide you with some guidance and further explanation.

I trust this information proves valuable as you think about ways to support the vital ministries of Faith Church while optimizing the available tax benefits in retirement. If you have further questions, please don't hesitate to contact me at the Church office.
