- Our Zambia Missionaries, the Groves, were provided \$5,000 of added support


for growing new churches from north to south Zambia. All children attending their preschool & tutoring program advance to secondary school.

Improvement from last year!




Attendance is up over 20% . Many are giving more.Thank you Gifts are up 1-2% from last year.
