

## **Faith United Methodist Community College and Vocational School Achievement Award**

**The Community College and Vocational School Achievement Award** is available for full-time students attending a community college or other institution for educational or occupational training in the fall following high school graduation and are not seeking a four year degree.

They must have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher and be an active member of Faith United Methodist Church for at least one year. Membership is determined by the date the applicant was confirmed and took membership vows with Faith United Methodist Church or whose parents are members of Faith United Methodist Church.

Applications may be submitted each year between January 1<sup>st</sup> and March 31<sup>st</sup>.

Each scholarship application is reviewed for completion of all required elements. Incomplete applications will not be considered and will not be returned.

Each application will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee and by a Volunteer Scholarship Reading Committee. After all applications are reviewed, the Scholarship Committee will review all recommendations and may request an interview with the applicant prior to approval of the award. If an interview is required, the applicant will be notified and an appointment will be scheduled.

Recipients of the award will be notified by the Scholarship Committee by the end of May. If an applicant does not receive a notification, it means he/she was not awarded the scholarship.

Payments are mailed directly to the school's financial aid office before the beginning of each school year. Checks are made payable to the school and not to the individual recipient.
